This year we will be studying the theme of forty days and forty nights based on stories from the Old and New Testaments. Booklets will be available in the churches - a donation of £3.00 is suggested towards production costs.

- WHEN?** The series will start on Shrove Tuesday (16th February) with 'Prayers and Pancakes', an ecumenical evensong held at St Winefride's Church, Leyborne Park at 8pm, followed by pancakes and refreshments.
- The Lent Groups will take place between 21st February and 24th March on a choice of evenings (Sunday, Monday or Tuesday) at 8.00 to 9.30pm. There will also be daytime groups at times to suit the participants.
- WHERE?** In homes around Kew.
- HOW OFTEN?** Once a week for five weeks.
